



The big screen for showing demos and such stuff was really big this year, and the sound system was also very good. The stage was just below the screen. After some hours the deadline for the C64 demo competition took place, and after yet some hours they showed the demos; Fairlight, Oxyron, Antic, Camelot, Censor, Dual Crew, Focus, Antic, Camelot, Censor, Dual Crev, Focus, Silicon Ltd., Wo.W. and Spirit. Anyhow the quality of the demos were really high, especially the Censor, Camelot and Fairlight demos that were really outstanding. I have to admit that I didn't notice too much of the graphics and music competitions so I couldn't give any reactions on them until after the compos. Then it was time for the voting, and I have to say that the voting system used couldn't be more unpractical. When checking in everyone received an Amiga voting disk, that was to be handed in at the information counter after voting. Well, that system sucks in three vays

They probably expect everyone to have an 1 Amiga. If you don't you have to borrow one to be able to vote.

2. When you're voting, each demo, music and picture has a certain number that must be ever since I joined Triad. The trip to Fredrikshawn, where the ferries leave from, was no problem as I slept all the time. Here we had a couple of hours to eat until the ferry was leaving for Sweden, so Unifier ve (Ι, Depeh. Zvron. Exalt. Bappalander, Bacchus, Spirou and Creeper) went to the traditional "Tonys Pizzas" But the servant was in a real bad mood this time, so we decided to eat somewhere else.
